### Church's Security Cameras

Some people of the congregation have asked questions about the security cameras which have been installed in the church. In the past, there has been some minor damage to or unwanted use of items in the church. The Church Board discussed what the church needs to do to protect it and to prevent serious damage to the church. They decided that it was either to keep the church locked when not in use or install security cameras.

The Perry Christian Church is the only church in Perry which is open for public use. It has been used as a safe haven during storms, to host aerobic classes, to host the Perry Prayer Shawl gatherings, a place for children to receive special support such as counseling and tutoring and some individuals have stated that they like to sit in the sanctuary to pray or read their Bible. If the church was locked, then for these types of activities to happen, someone must be available at any given time to open the church. The Board decided that they wanted the church to continue to remain open and to do that a security system needed to be installed.

The cameras are located at several places in the church. The cameras are activated by motion. The recorded videos are stored at the church, are viewed only by approved individuals from the church, and are only viewed by the church if something has happened. When something has happened, the videos are opened to the time that the incident occurred and are watched to gather information to resolve the incident.

NO ONE watches the videos just to see what is going on. The recorded videos are not seen by anyone other than those in the church who have been given access or by law enforcement, if needed. The recorded videos are kept for a limited time and then they are purged.
